MISSION:

In a capsule comment, the United States Army Security Agency has the mission of providing electronic communication security in support of the Field Armies and the National defense effort of the United States.

SCHOOL TRAINING:

There are many specialities in this field, so a capable young man can easily find a spot he's well qualified for. For example, unless already qualified in an Army specialty, you will be sent to an Army school for training which varies in length from approximately 8 weeks to 47 weeks. These schools are located all over the United States.

ASSIGNMENTS:

The United States Army Security Agency is represented world-wide in a variety of mobile and fixed units. Assignments are offered in the United States as well as in a number of foreign areas.

AND MEET THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM PREREQUISITES:

Be a high school graduate or the equivalent and meet the qualifications for enlistment and reenlistment prescribed in Army Regulations.

Make qualifying score in general technical test.

Be of excellent character and discretion and of unquestionable loyalty to the United States.

Be a United States citizen (spouse must also be a U. S. citizen).

Possess personal habits or traits of character unquestionable from a security standpoint.

Agree to enlist for a minimum period of four years.
